

Inaugural Workshop

The first meeting of the Network will be the pre-conference workshop in Hobart on 31st August 2016 prior to the DASSH Conference and AGM. This first meeting of the network will provide an opportunity for discussions about the nature of contemporary international engagement in our disciplines, the varied roles of associate deans, and the ways in which the network might support various kinds of cross-institutional collaboration.
