

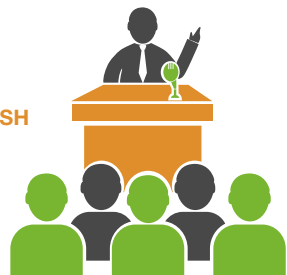

Advocates for and **promotes** the important contributions of the **Arts, Social Sciences and Humanities**.

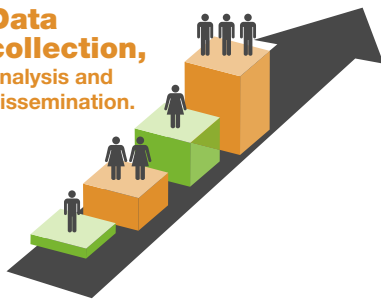

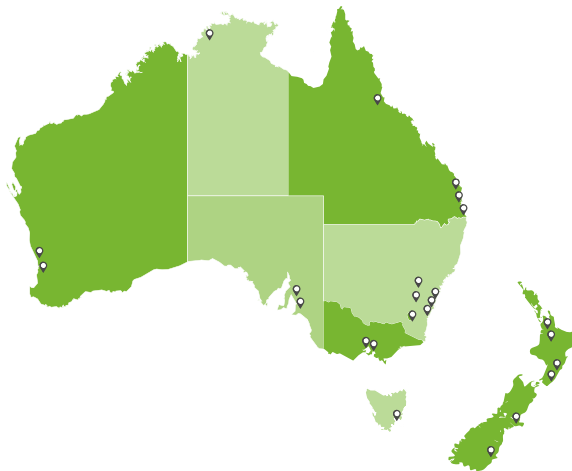

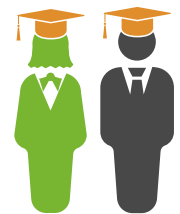


Recent projects
